- Describe IUCN Red List and the factors for determining conservations status according to the list
- Describe the case histories of three different species:
 - · One that has become extinct,
 - · Another that is critically endangered,
 - A third species whose conservation status has been improved by intervention.



Demonstrate that you have fully understood the ecological, socio-political and economic pressures that caused or are causing the chosen species' extinction. The species' ecological roles and the possible consequences of their disappearance should be understood.
